

Year 1 and 2 - Curriculum Overview and Homework Activities



Our learning



This term, our topic is 'The Lady with the Lamp'.

During our English lessons, we will focus on rhyming couplets, performance poetry, diary entries and non-fiction biographies learning about Florence Nightingale.

During Maths lessons, we will focus on the cornerstone concept of addition and subtraction. The children will learn how to add and subtract, including how to complete number sentences with missing numbers. We will be learning our number bonds to 10 and 100, finding 10 more and 10 less as well as fact-families.

In Science, we will learn about absorbency, exploring everyday materials, planning investigations and carrying out investigations with a wide variety of materials.

In History, we will be learning about Florence Nightingale and why she was called 'The Lady with the Lamp'. We will learn how to chronologically order events in her career and explain the impact that she had. We will also learn who Mary Seacole was, how she knew Florence Nightingale and identify the impact she had on medicine.

Computing lessons will further develop previous skills that have been taught. The children will learn how to use a computer and keyboard, dragging and clicking techniques, programming a character to grow and shrink and to follow instructions to follow a sequence.

In RE, the children will be learning about belonging and Christianity. We will understand the word 'belonging', identify symbols and understand why different events are celebrated.

In DT, the children will be using their fine motor skills to weave independently to create their own piece of material.

Reading every night is the most important thing you can do to support your child with their learning. Use the books sent home and the e-book library to support with this. There are weekly spellings to learn as well as TTROCKSTARS and time tables practice. We also set weekly Maths homework— your child will be given a sheet to stick in the homework book every Friday ready to complete each week.
